

Whitley Golf Club COVID 19 Opening Conditions
Updated 15/06/2020



Please read the relevant points below, regarding our conditions of opening. We will no doubt update these over the coming weeks, so please check the date of the latest update, so as to ensure you are up to date. We expect everyone to adopt our processes and respect that these are essential conditions to move forward.

Social distancing must be maintained at all times.

Those who do not comply will be asked to leave the property.

Opening conditions:

- * Tee times **only** 07:00 - 20:00 ; **maximum of 3 people** in a group only
- * Currently 9 Holes only
- * Arrive 10 minutes before tee time to pay/sign in, then proceed to the tee
- * Do not enter the 'Green Fee Desk' area if another customer is in there
- * Cash no longer accepted, card only and contactless if possible
- * No buggies available for public use
- * The clubhouse remains **Closed**, apart from access to Green Fee Door and access to the toilets
- * Do not use the changing rooms other than using the toilets
- * The bar is open for players to take drinks/snacks on to the course
- * Outside seating area currently not in use
- * Outside toilets closed
- * Shoe cleaning area closed
- * Wednesday Ladies & Friday Mens morning 'tee hours 9-10am' do not currently apply
- * Please use sanitiser before entering the building

On the Course:

- * If someone is on the 1st tee when you arrive at the tee, please wait by the whiteboard on the veranda until the tee is clear
- * Flags - they will remain present but **do not** touch them
- * Holes - the cups will be raised so when the ball hits the cup it is considered 'holed out', retrieve ball with gloved hand
- * Bunkers - rakes have been removed so please make efforts to smooth sand with a club or shoe
- * Tee pegs - **do not** pick up tee pegs that aren't yours
- * Golf balls - **do not** pick up any golf balls that aren't yours
- * Ball washers and benches - these will be out of service
- * Do not shake hands with playing partners
- * Avoid congregating on the course and maintain social distance at all times
- * When leaving the course please proceed up the grass path and through to the carpark, do not go back through towards the 1st tee
- * Golfers must leave the course and club immediately after the round and should not be gathering around the clubhouse or car park

Driving Range and practice area:

- * Driving Range – Open

- * Putting greens and chipping greens - remain open but please maintain social distancing at all times
